## RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE DIRECT DEPOSITS BY COLORADO COUNTY CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT

Whereas, the purpose of the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District (the "District") is for the preservation and conservation of its groundwater in accordance with Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code.

Whereas, the District shall begin to receive revenue from taxes beginning in October 2008, and the District desires to have those funds be deposited directly to the district banking account at First State Bank of Columbus,

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, the Board has, by official vote, approved the direct deposit of district funds by the Colorado County Central Appraisal District to the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District account at the First State Bank of Columbus,

Be It Further Resolved, that the Colorado County Central Appraisal District is hereby authorized to directly deposit funds to the First State Bank for a period of two years.
