IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1. Any amendment not defined as a Minor Amendment by CCGCD District Rules is considered to be a Major Amendment and shall be subject to all the requirements and procedures applicable to issuance of a new permit for a new well.
- 2. No application fee is required for an application for a minor amendment.
- 3. A minor amendment to a permit may be granted by the General Manager without notice, hearing or further action by the Board. A permittee may apply for a minor amendment for the following actions: (i) change in the name or address of the well owner without change in use; (ii) decrease in the maximum authorized withdrawal; (iii) conversion of two or more wells individually permitted by the same permittee into an aggregate system; or (iv) the addition of domestic or livestock use as a use to a permitted well without the maximum authorized withdrawal amount or rate being increased.
- 4. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that the Rules of the CCGCD will be followed. Lack of knowledge of the Rules is not a defense of violation of the Rules.
